

# TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP

Each day of camp offers an exciting new adventure for your camper. While activities vary, here's a sneak-peek at an average day at YMCA Camp.

6:30/7:00–9:00 AM

Campers have their choice of structured activities and snack in Before Camp-care. At 8:30 AM, DDC campers travel to their camp sites.



9:00–9:30 AM

Opening ceremonies reinforce the Y's four core values. Children can sing their hearts out, join in camp-wide games, giggle at staff skits, test their brains with food for thought or even give their counselors a messy treat!



9:30 AM–3:30 PM

After the opening ceremony, campers begin activities focused on that week's theme. One to two times a week your camper will cool off with a swim (times and days differ by site). In addition to lunch, time is allotted for breaks and quiet cool-down time where campers can read a book, play board games, work on art projects or engage in spirit-mind-body talks.



3:30–4:00 PM

After a fun-filled day, groups gather for their afternoon snack. As in the morning, groups enjoy a snack and prepare for the day's closing ceremonies and a summary of how the core values were used during the day. At 4:00 PM, campers travel to their pick-up location.



4:00–6:00 PM

When the camp day officially ends, a variety of camper-choice activities are available until caregivers arrive for pick-up sometime before 6:00 PM. Campers can catch up with friends, play games or just relax before they head home to rest up for another great day!


# SPORTS SPECTACULAR!


## PERFORMING ARTS

## ONLINE REGISTRATION BEGINS MARCH 1!

- For your convenience, we offer a weekly payment option via bank draft from a savings or checking account or through Discover®, American Express®, Visa® or Master Card®.
- Each week of camp must be paid in full two weeks prior to the program's start date.
- There is a \$25 registration fee per child, per program type.
- A \$10 per week deposit is applied to the weekly fee. Deposits are forfeited when a week is canceled.
- Registration fees and deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE and due at time of registration.
- There is a \$20 charge for schedule changes.
- Registrants with outstanding YMCA balances due will not be accepted. Please pay outstanding balances immediately or contact the Child Care Administrative Office to make arrangements. Failure to pay on time may jeopardize your child's camp enrollment. Full payment is required for children to attend camp.

## GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE

- All YMCA camp sites are state-licensed and accept the Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy (Except Adventure Club and Sports Spectacular).
- Camp sites licensed at the East & West YMCAs in Madison accept City of Madison funding.

## YMCA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- YMCA financial assistance is available to eligible applicants.
- In order to receive assistance, a YMCA financial assistance application must be approved before registration.

# HELPFUL TIPS

- Athletic shoes or hiking boots with socks

- Please send a healthy lunch with your child. Our days are filled with great activities, and children need lots of energy to play and grow.
