## SCHOOL AGE PROGRAMS

YSchool Age Child Care (SACC) is an exciting and challenging place, where children in grades K-5 (ages 5-12) stretch their skills in mind and body. Programs offer a combination of free-choice and structured activities. Expanded curriculum includes: arts and crafts, science, service learning, health & fitness, homework support, literacy, character development and conflict resolution. All programs promote the four core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. YSchool Age Child Care programs are State Licensed and Madison sites are City Accredited.

### YBEFORE SCHOOL

- Begins at 7:00am (6:30am in Sun Prairie) and children are released when the school bell rings.
- Balance of teacher-led and child initiated activities.
- Late Start program available Mondays at all Verona locations. (except Core Knowledge)

### YAFTER SCHOOL

- Starts when school lets out and ends by 5:45pm.
- Balance of teacher-led and child initiated activities.
- Nutritional snack provided.
- Program areas: active play, arts and crafts, games, building and imagination, quiet area, creative dramatics and homework table.
- Early release care on Mondays included at all Madison locations and Thursdays in Sun Prairie.
- Monthly early release care is included at all Middleton locations.
