WHAT TO DO WHEN THERE IS NO SCHOOL...

On most days that school is out, including teacher conferences and winter and spring breaks, the School Age Child Care department provides all day programs at various sites. School's Out Day Camp (SODC) days are made up of a variety of activities which may include field trips, swimming and special projects. Sites operating on these days may vary based on which school districts are out for the day. Registration and payment for School's Out Day Camp is separate from Before and After School registration.

- ✓ Enrollment is limited.
- ✓ Minimum of ten children needed to run program.
- ✓ All absences are required to be reported. (no refund of absences)
