SCHOOL AGE PROGRAMS

School Age Child Care (SACC) is an exciting and challenging place, where children in grades K-5 (ages 5-12) stretch their skills in mind and body. Expanded curriculum includes: arts and crafts, science, service learning, health & fitness, homework support, literacy, character development and conflict resolution. School Age Child Care programs are State Licensed and Madison sites are City Accredited.

AFTER SCHOOL

- Starts when school lets out and ends by 5:45pm.
- Balance of teacher-led and child initiated activities.
- Nutritional snack provided.
- Program areas: active play, arts and crafts, games, building and imagination, quiet area, creative dramatics and homework table.
- Early release care on Mondays included at all Madison locations and Thursdays in Sun Prairie.
- Monthly early release care is included at all Middleton locations.

BEFORE SCHOOL

- Begins at 7:00am (6:30am in Sun Prairie) and children are released when the school bell rings.
- Balance of teacher-led and child initiated activities.
- Nutritional snacks provided (East and Northeast).

LATE START

- Late Start program available Mondays at all Verona locations.
- Begins at 7:00am and ends when the school day begins.

SODC/SOFC

- On most days that school is out, the SACC department provides all day programs at multiple sites.
- A variety of activities may include; field trips, swimming, and special projects.

A completed registration packet and payment must be received 3 business days prior to children starting the program. All sites have limited enrollment.
